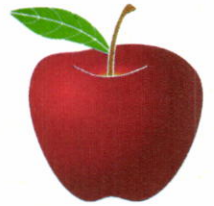

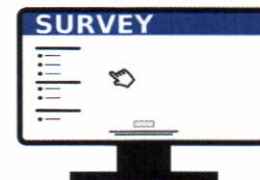
## Districtwide Survey
