Dear Steve Schorr ES Families and Community:

I hope everyone enjoyed our surprising weather and the unexpected snow. It is very rare for students to have a Snow Day in Las Vegas. March 22<sup>nd</sup> has been proposed as the make-up day, and the school board will vote on it on March 14<sup>th</sup>. You will be notified once this is finalized.

Our annual high-stakes testing for 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will begin on Monday, March 11<sup>th</sup> and will continue until Spring Break. Students will take computer-based Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium (SBAC) tests in reading and math. Fifth grade students also take a Science test. Please be sure that students are well rested and have a good meal. It is also extremely important that they attend school every day during our testing window.

Our average daily attendance for the month of February was 93.8%. Congratulations to Mrs. Maiello's class for winning the February attendance lunch. The average daily attendance from the beginning of the year until now is 95.3%. Our school is rated on attendance on our Nevada School Performance Framework, so we are aiming for at least 97%. We need to show improvement for the remainder of this year to meet the target.
